
### Pennsylvania Brings in \$1.85 Billion in Revenue Collections

General Fund revenue collections for the month of February were \$1.85 billion, which was \$51 million more than expected.

Collections of \$106 million for corporation taxes came in above Department of Revenue projections by \$48 million. Sales tax collections of \$668 million were lower than expected, coming in \$9 million below the official estimate. The Personal Income Taxes collected were \$821 million, which was below estimate by \$29 million.

Year-to-date General Fund collections of \$17.75 billion are above the official estimate by \$61 million.
