## 3 / CRISIS SERVICES

Delivers quick reference to all crisis intervention and emergency services, along with all available local and national hotlines for veterans.

## 4 / LIBRARY

Assembles more than 30,000 high-quality articles targeted to service members, veterans and family, including fact sheets and interactive tools for PTSD, TBI and Benefits.

- Vets4Warriors Peer Support provides 24/7 confidential support, information and referrals for all National Guard and Reserve service members.
- The Personal Health Record stores valuable medical, legal and service information and documents. It integrates seamlessly with the Common Access Card and the Network of Care – and is both HIPAA- and HL7-compliant.
- Each Web portal is fully customized to serve its specific location, with the ability for Network of Care partners to directly control local content and announcements.
- An advanced Social Networking platform is designed to help people connect, support, collaborate and coordinate with each other in meaningful ways.
