
Pennsylvania Brings in \$2.02 Billion in Revenue Collections

General Fund revenue collections for the month of August were \$2.02 billion, which was \$73 million less than expected.

Collections of \$45 million for corporation taxes came in below Department of Revenue projections by \$12 million. Sales tax collections of \$791 million were lower than expected, coming in \$52 million below the official estimate. The Personal Income Taxes collected were \$894 million, which was below estimate by \$18 million.

For the 2016-17 Fiscal Year, General Fund collections of \$3.99 billion are below the official estimate by \$73.6 million.

General Fund Revenue vs. Estimates


